MANAGEMENT QUOTA**

**NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB-OPTIONS FOR MOP-UP PHASE
COUNSELLING OF PG MEDICAL ADMISSIONS UNDER MANAGEMENT QUOTA.**

In continuation to this office notification dated: 07.08.2023, 23.08.2023, 11.09.2023, 21.09.2023 and 1-10-2023, KNRUHS hereby notifies the conduct of Mop-up phase of web-based counseling for allotment of the vacant Post Graduate seats under Management Quota MQ1 and NRI quota for admission into PG Medical courses for the academic year 2023-24 in Private Unaided Non-Minority and Minority Medical colleges in Telangana State affiliated to KNRUHS.

The candidates whose online uploaded certificates were provisionally verified and whose names are notified in the consolidated provisional final merit list for PG Medical Admissions on the website of KNRUHS Warangal on 01.10.2023 are eligible to exercise web - options online from computer with internet connection subject to following conditions:

The Candidates who were allotted seats in the previous phases of counseling and have not reported/discontinued the course at the respective college are not eligible for exercising options.

Candidates who have not exercised web options in the first phase of counseling are also not eligible to exercise web options in accordance with G.O.Ms.No.107& 108, HM&FW(C1) Department, Dated: 22-08-2022.

The candidates who were allotted PG seats in the previous phases of counseling and joined the course are also eligible to exercise web options and are informed to exercise web options

The candidates whose names are notified in the Competent Authority Quota counseling after MOP UP Phase for PG MEDICAL Courses are not eligible to exercise web options

The Candidates whose names are notified on MCC web site as admitted list of candidates after Mop-up phase of counseling PG MEDICAL Courses are not eligible for exercising options.

All the eligible candidates can exercise web-options from 01.00 PM on 10-10-2023 to 1.00 PM on 11-10-2023. As per the candidate's registration and eligibility for MQ-1, MQ-2 (NRI) categories, Candidates will have to exercise web options for the Post Graduate Medical seats as per their priority through <https://pvtspgmed.tsche.in> and allotments will be done accordingly.

NOTE: Candidates are informed that they will be considered only to the category / categories to which they have registered.

For eligibility criteria and regulations refer to notifications dated: 07-08-2023.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Allotted candidates have to pay the following University fee through payment gate way for downloading the allotment order. Candidates who have paid University fee in the previous phases need not pay again.

MQ 1 Management Quota sub category 1: Rs.49,600/-

MQ2 (NRI) & MQ3 (Institutional Quota) : Rs.69,600/-

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee is to be paid at respective Medical colleges. The tuition fee payable shall be as notified by Government of Telangana orders and as per relevant Hon'ble High Court orders.

NOTE:

The details of vacant seats available (seat matrix) in all Medical Colleges affiliated to KNRUHS are placed in the website <http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in> The candidates can exercise web options for PG Medical Degree / Diploma seats under KNRUHS through <https://pvtspgmed.tsche.in> .

Instructions to Candidates:

- 1) Eligible NEET-PG-2023 qualified Candidates as per provisional final merit list for Management Quota can exercise web options for Post Graduate Degree / Diploma seats in all Medical colleges as per their interest and priority for MQ1 and NRI categories(as per eligibility).

- 2) Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus for the Regulations for PG courses of KNRUHS, available on website before exercising web options.
- 3) Candidates exercising web options for PG Medical Degree / Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options, candidates can exercise options for any number of subjects and colleges the candidate is interested to join as per eligibility and registration.
- 4) Management Quota MQ-1 & MQ-2 (NRI) seats in Minority Medical Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only. If Muslim Minority Candidates are not available, the seats will be allotted to Non-Muslim Minority Candidates in the Last Phase of Counseling. Muslim Minority Candidates are also eligible for Management Quota seats in other Medical Colleges.
- 5) Candidates are advised to exercise web options for PG seats in all courses and colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available seats shown in seat matrix, as vacancies will arise during counseling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats in previous phases of counseling to other seats as per their web options in the Mop-up phase of counseling and vacant un- allotted service seats. If candidates are not interested to join in any subject or college they should not exercise web options for the same.
- 6) Candidates are also informed that allotted candidates in Management Quota Phase 2 who have been allotted seats in Competent Authority Quota Revised MOP Up Phase of KNRUHS are permitted to withdraw without penalty upto 12 noon on 11.10.2023. These seats also will be filled up in MOP UP phase of counseling. Accordingly candidates are advised to exercise Web-options in all courses and colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available seats shown in seat matrix.
- 7) If a PG seat is allotted in this phase of counseling as per web options exercised by the candidate in this phase of counseling, the seat allotted in previous phases of counseling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore the candidates are informed to exercise web options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.
- 8) Candidates can exercise web options through a computer either from home / any other place having internet facility. Don't use mobiles and Tabs for exercising web options.

- 9) One Time Password (OTP) will be sent to the registered mobile at the time of saving web options. The password consists of SIX letter code with English capitals A to Z (for details read instructions to the candidates before giving options).
- 10) Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options. Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if allotted. Candidates are also directed to check their allotment status on portal/website <https://pvttspgmed.tsche.in>
- 11) Candidates have to exercise options for MQ1 and if eligible for MQ2 (NRI) in order of priority for course and college. Allotments will be made according to the order of preference in the web options exercised by the candidate. Candidates have to exercise options very carefully as per their priority.
- 12) The selected candidates shall download the allotment letter from website after payment of the University fee by payment gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment details and report to the Principal of respective college on or before the last date specified on the allotment letter.
- 13) Selected candidates have to report at the respective colleges before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment letter, submit all original certificates, the relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee / college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within the specified date, the admission will be cancelled automatically.
- 14) If the candidate slides to other college during Mop-up phase of counseling, the original certificates will be sent to the college concerned after the closure of admissions. Candidates have to get relieved from previous phase joined college, obtain custodian certificate, collect fees and report to the allotted college before last date of joining.
- 15) Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the allotted college and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University Regulations

- 16) Candidates allotted seat under NRI Quota should produce the relevant sponsorship letter from NRI relative in Original along with copy of passport/ Residence Proof/Bank Statement or pass book of sponsor for NRI Category at respective colleges.
- 17) The names of all the candidates who are allotted seats after Mop-up phase of counseling shall be uploaded to the MCC portal and will not be eligible for AIQ stray vacancy counseling.
- 18) In accordance with the permission accorded by the Government vide Letter No. 7822/C1/2023, Dated: 08-09-2023.

Candidates admitted upto 2nd phase shall be permitted for up gradation upto mop up phase of counseling. The candidate is now allowed to exercise web options for mop-up phase of counseling. They will not be allowed to participate in any further rounds of Counseling after joining in Third Round of State Quota.

- 19) The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
