Sub:- KNRUHS – Exams – Conduct of Second MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations in the month of February 2024 – Issue of Notification – Regarding.

Ref:- Orders of the Vice – Chancellor, Dated:18.12.2023.

This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations commencing from **07.02.2024**.

1) Eligibility to appear for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations:

The MBBS students admitted by the KNRUHS during the academic year 2021-22 whose admissions are approved by the University and also students of previous batches who have failed, detained and not registered for the said examinations conducted earlier are eligible to appear for the examinations in February 2024 subject to the course regulations.

- 2) The Second MBBS students who are having minimum **75% ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICAL/CLINICAL** in each subject and scored minimum **50% (FIFTY PERCENT)** marks in internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- 3) The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the students is up to **05.01.2024**.
- 4) The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is from **09.01.2024** to **11.01.2024**.
- 5) The confirmation date for uploaded attendance and internal assessment marks is on **13.01.2024**.

6) **Digital valuation and providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:**

The University is a digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For MBBS course, single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page will be issued to the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.

7) The following amount should be paid by the candidates appearing for Second MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations:

2) **Criteria for passing in a subject:** A candidate shall obtain 50% marks in aggregate and 60:40 (minimum) or 40:60 (minimum) in University conducted examination separately in Theory and in Practical (practical includes; practical/clinical and viva voce) in order to be declared as passed in that subject.
