MBBS ADMISSIONS UNDER COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA 2024-25

NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB-OPTIONS FOR MOP UP PHASE OF COUNSELING

In continuation to this office notifications dated: 03-08-2024, 12-08-2024, 27-08-2024, 21-09-2024, 24-09-2024, 26-09-2024, 03-10-2024, 07-10-2024 and 17-10-2024, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences hereby notifies the conduct of Mop Up phase of web based counseling for vacant seats after second phase of Counselling and newly sanctioned seats of Nova Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Center, Hayathnagar under Competent Authority Quota (C.Q) for MBBS course for 2024-25 in Government, Private Medical Colleges in the State of Telangana.

Candidates whose names are notified as eligible candidates in the provisional final merit list of UG Medical Admissions on the KNRUHS website on 26-09-2024 and addendums are eligible to exercise web - options online from computer with internet connection.

All the eligible candidates whose names are displayed in the Provisional final merit list and addendums on KNRUHS website can exercise web options for admission into MBBS seats from **06.00 A.M. on 19.10.2024 to 06.00 P.M. on 20.10.2024** through website https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/ subject to following conditions:

- The Candidates who were allotted seats in the previous phases of counseling and have not reported/discontinued the course after joining at the respective college are not eligible for exercising options.
- 2. Candidates who have not exercised web options in the first phase of counseling are not eligible to exercise web options.
- 3. The candidates who were allotted MBBS seats in the previous phases of counseling and joined the course and continuing in the course are eligible to exercise web options and are informed to exercise web options.

For eligibility criteria and regulations refer to notifications dated: 03.08.2024.

UNIVERSITY FEE: Allotted Candidates have to pay University fee of Rs. 12,000/forMBBS Course through payment Gateway by using Online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and download the allotment letter. Candidates who have paid University fee in the previous phases need not pay again.

TUITION FEE: Tuition fee is to be paid at respective Medical colleges.

The tuition fee payable shall be as notified by Government of Telangana (notified on KNRUHS web site)

NOTE:

- The details of vacant seats available and Seat matrix of Nova Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Center, Hayathnagar are placed in the website http://knruhs.telangana.gov.in . Candidates can exercise web options for MBBS seats in all Medical colleges affiliated to KNRUHS through https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/.
- 2. The allotment of seats will be made in accordance with the selection procedure notified in Government orders G.O.Ms.No. 114 HM&FW(C1) Dept. Dated:05-07-2017, subsequent amendments, G.O. Ms. No. 125, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 22.09.2022, G.O. Ms. No. 75, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Dated: 04-07-2023, G.O. Ms. No. 33, Health, Medical and Family Welfare (C1) Department Horble High Court/Supreme court orders and University regulations.
- **3.** Admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw/discontinue from the course after Mop up phase of counseling.
- Candidates are informed that the allotments/admissions are subject to Orders of Hon'ble Courts in all pending cases.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES:

- Eligible NEET-UG-2024 qualified candidates as per provisional final merit list for Competent Authority Quota can exercise web options for vacant MBBS seats in Medical colleges as per their interest and priority subject to conditions stated above through https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/ from computer with internet connection.
- 2) Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus / Regulations for MBBS course and Government Orders on Rules of Admission notified on KNRUHS website before exercising web-options.
- 3) Competent Authority Quota seats in Minority Medical Colleges will be allotted to Muslim Minority Candidates only. Muslim Minority Candidates are also eligible for Competent Authority Quota seats in other Medical Colleges.
- 4) Admitted candidates will have to pay discontinuation penalty amount of Rs.20 lakhs as per Government Orders, if they discontinue the course after the Mop up phase of counseling to get their original certificates back. Candidates also will be debarred for 3 years for MBBS admission under KNRUHS to prevent seat blocking.
- 5) If a candidate is allotted a seat in MBBS course as per his/her web-options in this phase and does not join the course, penalty clause shall be applicable including penalty amount of Rs. 20.00 lakhs and debarment for 3 years to prevent seat blocking.
- 6) Candidates exercising web-options for MBBS course are informed that there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web-options. Candidates can exercise web options for any number of colleges the candidate is interested to join as per candidate's eligibility. If candidates are not interested to join in any college, they should not exercise weboptions for the same.
- 7) Candidates are advised to exercise web options for MBBS seats in all colleges in which they are interested to join irrespective of available vacant seats shown in seat matrix, as vacancies will arise during counseling process due to sliding of candidates from allotted seats in previous phases of counseling to other seats as per their web options in the Mop Up phase of

counseling

- 8) If a seat is allotted in this phase of counseling as per web options exercised by the candidate in this phase of counseling, the seat allotted in previous phases of counseling will be automatically cancelled and allotted to the other candidate. Therefore, candidates are informed to exercise web options carefully for sliding with awareness of this fact.
- 9) One time pass word will be sent to the registered mobile number at the time of exercising web-options. The pass word consists of SIX letter code with English capital A to Z. (For details read construction to the candidates before giving options)
- 10) Candidates are instructed to take a print out of saved options.
- 11) Candidates will receive SMS message on their registered mobile after allotment of seat, if allotted. Candidates are directed to login to check their allotment status on https://tsmedadm.tsche.in/ website after each phase of counseling without fail.
- 12) The selected candidates shall download the allotment letter from website after payment of the University fee by gateway method by using online payment method. (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates should check their allotment and report to the Principal of respective Medical college on or before the date specified on the allotment letter.
- 13) Selected candidates have to report to the Principal of the respective Medical college before the last date for joining as specified on the allotment letter, submit all original certificates, relevant bonds and pay the tuition fee/college fee to complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfill the above criteria to complete the admission process within specified date for joining, the admission will be cancelled automatically and penalty clause shall be applicable including penalty amount of Rs. 20.00 lakhs and debarment for 3 years to prevent seat blocking.
- 14) If the candidate slides to other college during Mop up phase of counseling in Medical colleges affiliated to KNRUHS, the original certificates will be sent to the Medical college concerned after the closure of admissions.

Candidates have to get relieved from previous phase joined Medical college, obtain custodian certificate, collect fees and report to the allotted Medical college before last date of joining. Admitted candidates shall not be permitted to discontinue from the course after allotment in Mop Up phase of Counselling

- 15) Candidates are hereby informed that final verification of original certificates will be conducted at the allotted Medical College and in case of any discrepancy, the provisional allotment will be cancelled and action may be initiated as per University regulations.
- 16) In accordance with the clause for upgradation notified by MCC in the Information Bulletin, candidates admitted upto second round shall be permitted to exercise web options for upgradation to Mop Up round of Counselling. Admitted candidates are not permitted to withdraw from the course after Mop Up phase of counselling.
- 17) Original certificates submitted at the time of admissions shall not be returned to candidate, unless the candidate discontinues the course before Mop Up phase of counseling or before the last date for free exit to be notified by the University.
- 18) The University fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
