## FIRST MBBS (NEW REGULATIONS) REGULAR EXAMINATIONS NOTIFICATION, SEPTEMBER 2025

Sub:- KNRUHS – Exams – Conducting of First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular examinations in the month of September, 2025 – Issue of Notification – Regarding.

Ref:- Orders of the Vice – Chancellor, Dated: 30.06.2025.

This notification is issued for registration of the candidates to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations commencing from **02.09.2025**.

### **Eligibility to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular Examinations:**

- 1. The First MBBS students who have been admitted during the academic year **2024-25** into the medical colleges affiliated to KNRUHS in Telangana State, whose admissions are approved by the KNRUHS and also the students of previous batches who have failed, detained or not appeared for the examinations conducted earlier i.e., not more than four attempts are eligible to appear for First MBBS (New Regulations) Regular examinations in the month of September, 2025.
- 2. The First MBBS students who are having minimum 75% ATTENDANCE IN THEORY AND 80% ATTENDANCE IN PRACTICAL/CLINICAL and scored minimum 50% MARKS in internal assessment examinations in each subject are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- 3. The Cut-off date for calculation of attendance percentage of the students is up to 31.07.2025.
- 4. The uploading of the attendance percentage and internal assessment marks of the students is from <u>05.08.2025</u> to <u>07.08.2025</u>.
- 5. The confirmation date for uploaded attendance and internal assessment marks is on <u>10.08.2025</u>.

As per the NMC, New Delhi, Regulations under Rule No. 11.2.7 for 2019-20 Admitted Batch onwards, no more than four attempts shall be allowed for the candidate to pass First Professional examinations. The total period for successful completion of first Professional course shall not exceed four (4) years. Partial attendance of examination in any subject shall be counted as an attempt. A learner shall not be entitled to Graduate later than ten (10) years of her/his joining the first MBBS course.

### **Special Note to 2019 batch and 2020 batch students:**

- In pursuance to the NMC, New Delhi circular Dated:12-05-2023 of the Secretary, National Medical Commission, New Delhi, wherein it was circulated to allow one additional attempt (5th attempt) to such MBBS students who are admitted in Medical Colleges during the academic year 2019 -20 & could not pass their First Professional MBBS Examinations.
- The National Medical Commission vide No. U.13021/01/2023/UGMEB/, Dated:11.12.2023 has decided to allow one additional attempt (5th attempt) to such MBBS Students who were admitted in medical colleges during the academic year 2020-21 and could not pass their first professional MBBS examination, as this batch was also affected by COVID 19 Pandemic. This shall be a one-time measure and may not be treated as a precedence for future.

# <u>Digital Valuation and Providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:</u>

The University is a Digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. **For First MBBS**, exam will be conducted with single answer booklet with candidate specific bar code on each page for the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet only.
